It's officially summer on the calendar even though it's still a little chilly. As The summer season approaches and the air warms up there are more activities available. We all need to remember that here is a 14 day window that these items can be parked in our driveways. Please remember this is in our CCRs for our neighborhood. If it exceeds the 14 day window you will receive a letter advising you the limit has been exceeded and immediate action will need to take place on your part to remove the items. There is a shortage of storage in McCall but there are still places available in the surrounding area that have storage available.

Also please be aware that the CCRs also prohibit short term rentals and running businesses out of your home in our neighborhood. Please do not consider this as an option. Many of our neighbors purposely bought their homes in our neighborhood based on this. Lets all obey the CCRs that we agreed to when we bought our homes in the Woodlands.

Also there have been some concerns brought to the board regarding the pups in the neighborhood. People like to walk and don't like dogs running up to them. Many have had bad experiences. Dogs owners: lets be aware of others and if your pup is unable to stay in their yard lets try to be aware and keep them close. My fear is if they are out wandering the possibility of them getting hit is much greater. I know they are a huge part of your family it would be awful to lose them. Lets keep them safe and be aware of their abilities and if they need more training lets keep up the training to keep them safe. So please supervise your pup when they are outside so they don't harass the walkers in the neighborhood and don't do their duty in your neighbors yard. The city does have ordinances on having your dog on leash and picking up after them. I've seen great improvements in that area in our neighborhood. Good Job Dog owners!! Keep it up!
