Firewise Committee Offers Tips for Homeowners

A message from Al King, Chair of our Firewise Committee:

As our wildfire season is rapidly approaching, all Woodlands residents are encouraged to take advantage of the free woody debris drop-off programs offered by the McCall Fire District and Valley County.

During the month of June, woody debris (e.g. tree limbs, brush, pine needles, etc.) may be dropped-off for free in the large dumpster across the street from the McCall Fire Station on Deinhard Road. During the months of June and October woody debris can also be dropped-off for free at the Valley County Transfer Site.

Woodlands residents are encouraged to refer to the "Firewise Tips for Homeowners" which provides excellent guidance on reducing the wildland fire risk to residences. This is posted on the Contacts page of our website: www.woodlandsmccall.org, with contact info for the Committee members.
